2 Upon completion of an AA degree before transferring, FSU only requires 3 hrs. of international/diversity coursework(EDF2085).
3 Must take AMH 2010 and AMH 2020 and two courses (6) from the following subject area. POS, ECO, WOH, or GEA. Must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.
4 Prerequisites: Must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.
5 FSU requires one Natural Science course with a Lab to be completed before graduation. Must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. This is not an admission requirement.
6 Students enrolled in AA, AS, or BS degree programs must complete the State of Florida's Civic Literacy requirement as outlined in section 1007.25(4), Florida Statutes (F.S.). See catalog or contact an Academic Advisor for more information.
